

FBC Acts of Love/Day of Community Service

Feeding Ministries

- **Kitchen of Hope** - Prepare and serve a hot meal plus pray with recipients, and cleanup. Meal service is 3:30-5pm so opportunity is 11am-5:30pm. Family friendly with children supervised by parent/guardian. May need shopper to obtain food not in stock in pantry prior to service date. Desire 6-8 adults.
- **Salvation Army Soup Kitchen** - Help the one employee cook and serve lunch for 40-80 guests and then clean up during 11am-1:30pm. There may be an opportunity to interact with guests. Family friendly with children supervised by parent/guardian. Desire 5 adults.
- **Second Harvest Food Bank** - Assemble food bags for local schools and prepare mobile food bank trucks. Family friendly but children must be 10 or older. Can carpool from FBCK for 20-25-minute drive to airport exit. Desire 9-12 volunteers can accommodate up to 20. Two flexible sessions (9:30am-12:30pm; 1-4pm).
- **Gibsontown Ministries** - Help assemble and distribute 100 BBQ meals in the Cloud Park area as part of Easter recognition. Easter treat bags will also be given out to children. Desire 1 family or 4 volunteers from 2:45-5:00pm.
- **Meals on Wheels** - Deep clean and organize the kitchen storage areas at Waverly Road Presbyterian as guided by the MoW cooking coordinator. Desire 4-6 adult volunteers (or high school youth) for estimated 4-hour project.

Construction & Cleaning Ministries

- **Sleep in Heavenly Peace** - Build beds for kids who are sleeping on floors and couches under guidance of the organization's volunteer leadership. All tools and supplies provided. Need two trucks in morning at Lowes to pick up supplies. Can accommodate up to 20 volunteers. Beginner construction skills required. All day project.
- **Salvation Army Shelter** - Help maintain the shelter by any of three tasks: replacing designated window blinds, painting stairwell and hallways, or cleaning surfaces and walls. Can use up to 12 volunteers. All day project.
- **Friends in Need Clinic** - Freshen up the dental/medical clinic by painting hallways, break room, and some offices (scale to number of volunteers). Can accommodate up to 12 volunteers. All day project.
- **KCMC** - Help renovate new space for the relocated agency, possibly light construction, painting, and/or moving a food bank to another room. Project details still need to be finalized. Can accommodate up to 12 volunteers. All day project.
- **Kingsport Homeless Ministry** - Deconstruct old shade pavilions by removing broken plastic roofing panels and the associated aluminum framework holding them in place. Plans are to use salvaged materials the courtyard of the new Kingsport Homeless Ministry shelter/day center on East Sullivan Street where they will be installed on concrete pads and new roofs will be added to provide needed shaded area. Desire up to 6 volunteers from 9:30am-4pm.
- **Family Promise** - Clean out flower beds around the day house on Holston Street. May plant flowers as well. Family friendly. Desire 4-12 volunteers beginning at 9:30am - finish time depends on the number of volunteers.

Thrift Store Ministries

- **Habitat ReStore** - Help manage a section of the store and/or receive and move donations through stock room. Must be at least 16 years old and able to properly lift up to 35-50-pound items to volunteer. Waiver required. Desire 10 volunteers per session (9:30am-12:30pm and 12:30-3:30pm). May volunteer for more than 1 session.
- **Mission Agape** - Help with Community Day distribution of diapers, wipes, food, and clothing to families with small children. Volunteers needed inside (manage distribution needs) and outside (manage parking lot traffic, pray with families, take family information and runners (fill orders and deliver back to vehicle)). Desire 3-5 volunteers from 9:30am-12:30pm.

Social Support Ministries

- **Meal Delivery** - Take meals prepared at Kitchen of HOPE to those with mobility challenges, identified from HUGG and homebound ministries. Each delivery is 15-20-minute visit/prayer. Family friendly. Desire 8 drivers from 3-5pm.
- **Gibsontown Ministries** - Help assemble Easter treat bags for children to be given out at the BBQ gathering hosted by Gibsontown Ministries in Cloud Park. Volunteers are needed to assemble Easter treat bags beginning at 1:00 pm, then to set up an Easter egg hunt in Cloud Park at 3:00pm, facilitate egg hunt and help clean up afterwards. Desire 2 families, roughly 8 volunteers from 1-5:30pm.
- **Visitation** - Scheduled visit with those with mobility challenges identified from HUGG and homebound ministries. Each visit is 1 hour. Desire 10-12 volunteers.

Prayer Team Ministry

- Dedicated prayer team members are asked to pray specifically for this project daily, from the time of signup through completion of event day. Please pray for *Acts of Love* planning team, volunteers, the ministries we will be serving, our church, and our community.
